African Dwarf Doormouse

(Graphiurus murinus)



Country of Origin: Africa, south of the Sahara.

Diet: A variety of food should be offered every day including fruit, nuts, seeds and insects. Commercial available hamster mix with raw peanuts and sunflower seeds is suitable. A favourite is ripe banana but fresh food consumption should be closely monitored to ensure excess has not spoiled. Water should be constantly available.

Social Groupings: These are social animals and should be kept in small groups. They will live happily in single sex groups if introduced at a young age.

Accommodation: A large tank with a fine wire mesh lid as these little creatures can escape through the tiniest gap! A deep layer of wood shavings, some nesting material and lots of climbing equipment are necessary to keep these busy animals happy. Dwarf dormice will also need a nesting box, either commercially bought or improvised with a cardboard box or tube. They must be kept warm, at least 21°C (70°F) otherwise they will begin to hibernate.
